

## Internet Explorer 5 and above

- 1. Select **Internet Options** from the **Tools** menu.
- 2. In **Internet Options** dialog box select the **Security** tab.
- 3. Click the **Custom Level...** button. The Security Settings dialog box will pop up.
- 4. Under **Scripting** category enable **Active scripting**.
- 5. Click **OK** twice to close out.
- 6. Click **Refresh**.

## Netscape 7.X

- 1. Select **Preferences** from the **Edit** menu.
- 2. Click the arrow next to **Advanced**.
- 3. Click **Scripts & Plug-in**.
- 4. Check Navigator beneath "**Enable JavaScript for**".
- 5. Click **OK**.
- 6. Click **Reload**.

## Netscape 6.X

- 1. Select **Preferences** from the **Edit** menu.
- 2. Click **Advanced**
- 3. Check **Enable JavaScript for Navigator**
- 4. Click **OK**.
- 5. Click **Reload**.

## Opera 7.X

- 1. Select **Quick Preferences** from the **File** menu.
- 2. Make sure **Enable JavaScript** is checked.
- 3. Click **Reload**.

## Mozilla 3.6.X and above

- 1. Select **Options** from the **Tools** Menu
- 2. Select **Content** tab
- 3. Make sure **Enable JavaScript** is checked

## Safari 4.X

- 1. Select **Preferences** from the **Edit** menu.
- 2. Click the **Security tab**.
- 3. Click **Scripts & Plug-in**.
- 4. Check "**Enable JavaScript**".
- 5. Close **Security** window.
- 6. Close and reopen the **browser**.
